It is part of a Prevention Package which is included in the Commission Work Programme 2023 and is expected to be adopted at Commission level in the third quarter of 2023. The Commission proposal for a Council Recommendation on vaccine-preventable cancers aims to help Member States address vaccine-preventable cancers with a focus on increasing the uptake of vaccination against Human papillomaviruses (HPV) and Hepatitis B virus (HBV).

Dotation:


EUR 20,000 for the best clinical and/or epidemiological paper; EUR 20,000 for the best basic science, translational paper.
