European Testing Week is a European initiative that urges stakeholders throughout Europe — in community, health care and policy institutions — to join forces for one week twice a year to improve testing efforts and raise awareness about the benefits of earlier hepatitis and HIV testing. Since its inception in 2013, this project has evolved to become a well-known European event, with hundreds of groups taking part each year.

The Spring and Autumn European Testing Weeks continue to have the same goal: "to unite partner organisations throughout Europe for one week to increase access to testing and promote awareness on the benefits of earlier hepatitis and HIV testing".

#### WAVE message for Mother's Day 2023

#### A Happy Mother's Day with HIV? Absolutely!

Why talk about HIV on the occasion of Mother's Day?

Approximately 1.3 million women and parents living with HIV per year give birth. Access to HIV testing and treatment has improved for HIV in pregnancy, with vertical transmission rates decreasing by more than half over the last decade globally. However, we have not yet reached the goal of zero vertical transmissions.

Moreover people living with HIV still face particular challenges. Fearing HIVrelated stigma and discrimination, most women and parents hide their HIV diagnosis from others to protect their children, thus having to live a double life with a heavy family secret.

Women Against Viruses in Europe (WAVE) is committed to improving the lives of women and parents living with HIV and works to eliminate HIV-related discrimination against all. Mother's Day is a fitting opportunity to raise awareness about this issue.

The EACS Award is handed out every two years at the time of the European AIDS Conference in recognition of an individual's longstanding, impactful and sustained professional contribution to the field of HIV.

Contributions worthy of this recognition are expected to reflect sustained excellence in the field of HIV. Such contributions may be scientific in nature, and/or relate to advancing the prevention and care of people at risk of or affected by HIV, or to promoting education, policy, community engagement or advocacy.

The recipients will be announced at the Opening Ceremony of the 19th European AIDS Conference on Wednesday 18 October 2023 in Warsaw.

EACS members are invited to submit a nomination for the EACS Award by 20 June.

#### Apply for the Hector Research Award!

The H.W. & J. Hector Foundation, Weinheim, is announcing a prize for European HIV research, which will be awarded for the best scientific achievements in the HIV research area in 2022/2023.

Dotation: EUR 20,000 for the best clinical and/or epidemiological paper; EUR 20,000 for the best basic science, translational paper.

Any paper on an HIV-related topic that has been accepted or published in a peer-reviewed journal within the last 24 months (i.e. from 18 October 2021) before the start of the 19th European AIDS Conference (#EACS 2023) can be submitted.
