Apply for the HIV Summer School

Applications for the EACS HIV Summer School are still open. The course will take place from **31 August-4 September 2026** in **Lyon, France.**

This 5-day residential course is designed for clinicians involved in HIV management who wish to deepen their knowledge about all aspects of HIV medicine and research methodology. The course is delivered by an experienced faculty of key opinion leaders in the fields of HIV clinical care and research.

Teaching is based around a combination of plenary sessions, which provide updates on the recent advances in HIV clinical science and a general introduction to clinical research methodology, and interactive small working groups led by faculty members.

A maximum of 60 participants will be accepted.

A moderate fee of EUR 400 is charged which will cover registration and accommodation (payment is due on confirmation of a place in the course). A limited number of scholarships are available to applicants from low-income countries.

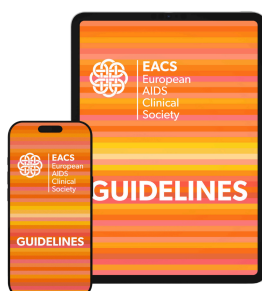
