The next EACS Live! Journal Club will take place on **Wednesday, 17 September at 15:00 CEST**.

The **September** session will focus on **Quality of Life for People Living with HIV: Clinical Insights and Community Responses**

The session will bring together clinical and community perspectives on improving the lives of people with HIV. Drawing on findings from the nationwide CoRIS cohort in Spain, we will present research on health-related quality of life (HRQoL), its associated factors and changes over time, as well as physicians' views on measuring HRQoL in routine care and potential clinical interventions.

We will also examine non-medical approaches to HIV testing and the role of non-governmental organisations in shaping effective prevention strategies. Innovative, community-led initiatives will be showcased, highlighting how grassroots engagement strengthens public health responses and fosters sustainable, inclusive models of care.
