Participate in the May EACS Live! Journal Club

The next EACS Live! Journal Club will take place on Wednesday, **21 May** at **14:00 CEST** and will focus on **HIV-1 drug resistance to Integrase Strand Transfer Inhibitors (INSTIs)**.

Integrase Strand Transfer Inhibitors (INSTIs) are now considered a cornerstone of combination antiretroviral therapy. Resistance to INSTIs in HIV treatment is relatively uncommon, particularly with the use of second-generation agents, but can occur. In this Journal Club we will discuss the resistance patterns during second-generation INSTI failure and the risk factors for developing resistance. Special focus will be given to dolutegravir resistance due to its widespread use as a first-line antiretroviral agent globally.

EACS is coming to Prague in 2027!



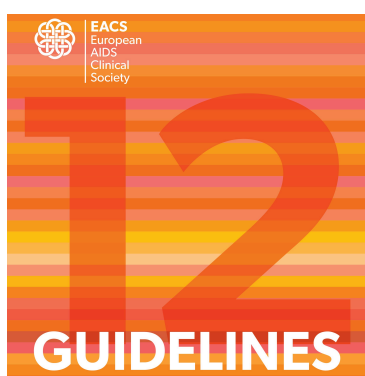

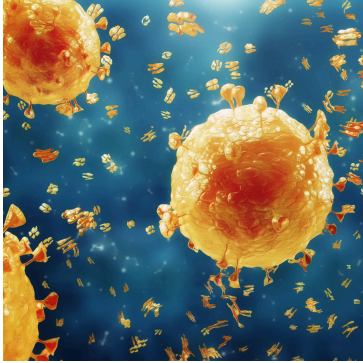
