This interim update includes minor modifications following the comments received from EACS members after the release of V12.1 at the HIV Glasgow Conference.

Changes are included in Part I, section IV, in the chapters of ART in people with TB/HIV Co-infection, PrEP and References.

EACS would like to thank all members who submitted comments and questions. All comments were considered and discussed. This new version includes those approved for immediate modification while others may be discussed and eventually implemented in V13.0.

Complete the AAF PrEP Survey on HIV care and prevention continuum among migrants living in European countries


The **Africa Advocacy Foundation** is conducting a survey that will help to better understand migrants' access to PrEP in the UK and EU countries.


