The Diploma is designed for healthcare professionals working in HIV care and aims to support efforts to **harmonise clinical practice across Europe**, while addressing the lack of recognised specialisation in HIV medicine within postgraduate training.

Recognising the diversity of practices across countries, the diploma will help **establish minimal standards of education and training in the field**. It is intended to ensure that practitioners possess the core knowledge, skills, attitudes, and competencies essential for effective HIV medicine practice.

The first **European Diploma in HIV Medicine examination** will take place on 25 September 2025 and is designed to assess professional competencies in HIV management through Single-Best Answer (SBA) questions. It offers clinicians an opportunity to:

- Demonstrate clinical proficiency through certification
- Benchmark their knowledge against defined European standards
- Support their continued professional development
- Strengthen professional mobility within the field of HIV care
