The Diploma is designed for healthcare professionals working in HIV care and aims to support efforts to harmonise clinical practice across Europe, while addressing the lack of recognised specialisation in HIV medicine within postgraduate training.

Recognising the diversity of practices across countries, the diploma will help establish minimal standards of education and training in the field. It is intended to ensure that practitioners possess the core knowledge, skills, attitudes, and competencies essential for effective HIV medicine practice.

The first European Diploma in HIV Medicine examination will take place on 25 September 2025 and is designed to assess professional competencies in HIV management through Single-Best Answer (SBA) questions. It offers clinicians an opportunity to:

- Demonstrate clinical proficiency through certification
- Benchmark their knowledge against defined European standards
- Support their continued professional development
- Strengthen professional mobility within the field of HIV care
