Description:

The Erasmus MC is a large University Medical Center in The Netherlands. We provide clinical care to ~ 2500 HIV-1 positive adults, ~ 75 HIV-1 positive children, and ~ 50 HIV-2 positive adults. In addition, we provide clinical consultation and HIV diagnostics to other centers in The Netherlands and abroad. Our research activities focus on antiretroviral drug resistance (in particular INSTIs), new mechanism of antiretroviral drug resistance, HIV cure research, mathematical modelling of the impact of HIV prevention and emergence of HIV drug resistance, HIV-2. Our HIV clinical research includes HIV therapy studies with putative 'stellar' cure drug trials (LUNA, ORBIT, STAR, PLUTO) and HIV test and care awareness programs, within 2 European consortia on cure (EU2Cure, www.eu2cure.com) and HIV care (www.awarehiv.com) as coordinator. Erasmus MC collaborates with multiple centers within The Netherlands and abroad. The program will take place in the Erasmus MC.
